Consider a resolution canvassing and declaring the results of the November 3, 2020 election regarding a proposition to decrease the current one-half of one percent (0.5%) sales and use tax for the benefit of the Type B economic development corporation to one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) and adopt a local sales and use tax in the City of Alvarado at the rate of one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.
