- Announcements involving an imminent threat to the public health and safety of people in the municipality that has arisen after the posting of the agenda.

BACKGROUND & FINDINGS:

Each quarter, staff is proposing to install a new book in the display stands at Parkway Park. The first book was installed in February 2026, and the second book was recently installed in April 2026. For the third quarter, the third book will be placed on display at the beginning of July, and the fourth book sometime in October 2026.

Staff seeks assistance from the Library Advisory Board in changing books out consistently each quarter. The process of changing out the books is time consuming for one staff member to complete. When staff install the latest book was in April, it took staff approximately two hours to complete this task. Staff is requesting support from the Library Advisory Board members with changing out the books each quarter to make the process more efficient.
