- Information regarding a social, ceremonial, or community event organized or sponsored by an entity other than the governing body that was attended or is scheduled to be attended by a member of the governing body or an official or employee of the municipality; and
- Announcements involving an imminent threat to the public health and safety of people in the municipality that has arisen after the posting of the agenda.

The Christmas parade will be on December 12. The library will not do a float but will help with activities.

Summer activities: Movie marathon and bingo for kids.
